### “Broderie Perse Medallion”

A perfect class for those who have always wanted to try Broderie Perse, or those who applique that never grow tired of discovering new designs created from well-defined floral motifs.

The 36” medallion contains a circular arrangement of floral print blooms, incidental flowers, and longer stems, interspersed with English Paper Piecing, (EPP,) flowers made in harmonious colors. (There are four 3/4” Hexagon flowers and twelve 3/4” Pentagon flowers.)

Note: If you have done English Paper Piecing (EPP) before, you can bring finished flowers, ready to go.

If you have NEVER done EPP before, do not worry! I will teach you Di Ford Hall’s great method for making them.

The surrounding border is simply an idea for my medallion. Hopefully, you will take yours home, completely stitch it, add complimentary borders of your own design, then bring it back completed next year!
