SUPPLY LIST		
Centre Squares for baskets I used 8 different grey fabrics. An 8" strip of fabric will give you 5 baskets. Cut each square at 6 ½" x 6 ½"	Baskets I used large florals in various colours for the basket body and handle. For the base and lip of the basket I used fabric with smaller prints, choosing a colour from the large florals	Flanged border/binding (2 ½") Orange/white stripe fabric
2nd, 3rd and 4th Border 2 ½ yards - of a dark grey fabric. I used Grey Matters but I don't think its available anymore (sorry)	Rectangles $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares papers. You need 112 squares. (I cut these to $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 1")	Fabric for Rectangles I used the same large florals for all rectangles.
Fabric for 3rd Border		
Leaves - I used 3 different greens and a blue/white stripe on the long borders. I used a third green fabric for the leaves in the corner blocks.	<b>Vine -</b> I used a black/white fabric. You will require 71" of a ½" stem.	Flowers/Birds - An assortment of fabrics. Bring fat quarters, fat eights and lots of other fabric.

Needles I use Jeana Kimball No. 10 straw needles but bring your favourite	Glue Roxanne's glue - I like this small bottle as it has a small "spout" which is easy to unplug if any glue gets stuck in it.		
Circles Karen Kay Buckley Circles available from her website:  https://www.karenkaybuckley.com/store.php?cat=2	Thread  EF02 EF15  Cotton thread. I use Wonderfil Efina 60W		
Spray Starch  Best Press - available from any good quilting shops.	Clover Bias Maker  1/4 inch Clover Bias Tape Maker and a metal pin (not with a plastic head as it will melt when pressing)		
Fabric Pens	A.A.A (==1)		
Frixion pens are great as they disappear with heat. I usually use the black pens. These are the two that I use. The retractable pens have a fine point (Pilot FriXion Clicker Retractable Gel Ink Pens, Eraseable, Fine Point 0.7 mm, Black Ink (314505P)			
I also love the felt tipped pens which are great for ease of drawing. (FriXion Colors Erasable Marker Pen s, Bold Point, Assorted Color Inks - 12-Pack (44155)
