Background – $70 \text{cm} / \frac{3}{4} \text{ yd}$ Pot body – Fat $^{1}/8$ Pot rim – $8'' \times 3''$ strip Gold inserts in pot body – 4'' square Gold handle knobs – scrap Stems – $30 \text{cm} / ^{1}/3 \text{yd}$ of 3 greens (Can use only one if preferred) Leaves – Small amounts of a variety of greens or Fat $^{1}/8$ of one Flowers – Small amounts of pinks (5), reds (2), rusts (3), Gold (2) & purple (1) or Fat $^{1}/8$ of each colour

| Aurifil Cotton Mako 40 or 80 (or preferred thread) for hand appliqué to match fabrics. | Rotary cutting equipment (Rotary cutter, ruler & cutting mat) |

| Scissors for cutting fabric, & paper | Mechanical pencil including coloured leads depending on fabrics used. (0.7mm 2B) I also use a Silver or gold non-acidic gel pen to mark stitching lines on appliqué motifs |
| Clover ¼" Fusible Bias Maker Clover ¼" Fusible Web or glue if preferred | Sticky tape to stick full sized pattern pieces together |
| Applipops or Perfect Circles (Optional) | Fusible web (sample block has a small amount of blanket stitch appliqué at the top of pot. This can be needle turned if preferred |
