Cutting Instructions for the complete quilt

Centre Squares: 4 @ 18 ½" x 18 ½"

Grunge hits the spots #30149 by Basic Grey for Moda.



Daisy Circles: 9 @ 7" x 7"

Medium dots light grey #13008 by Tilda



1st Border: 4 @34 ½" x 6 ½" strips

strips 4 @ 6 ½" x 6 ½"

Classic Basics Pen Stripe Grey #130033 by Tilda



2nd Border (Orange)

5 @ 2" strips - sew strips together and then cross cut 2 @ 46 ½" strips and 2 @ 49 ½" strips.



3rd Border (Blue/cream stripe) 7 @ 6 ½" strips -

7 @ 6 ½" strips sew strips together and then cross cut 4 @ 65" strips

Fabric by Day in the Country.



Flowers/leaves/stems/circles

An assortment of fabrics - raid your stash for fat quarters, fat eights, small pieces of fabric, large pieces.....

Pattern

Glue

Roxanne's glue - I like this small bottle as it has a small "spout" which is easy to unplug if any glue gets stuck in it.



Needles

I use Jeana Kimball No. 10 straw needles but bring your favourite


Scissors

Small embroidery scissors for appliqué Fabric scissors – for cutting larger shapes

Fabric Markers

Frixion pens are great as they disappear with heat. I usually use the black pens. These are the two that I use. The retractable pens have a fine point (Pilot **FriXion Clicker** Retractable Gel Ink Pens,

Eraseable, Fine Point 0.7 mm, Black In (314505P)

Clover Bias Maker

1/4 inch Clover Bias Tape Maker and a metal pin (not with a plastic head as it will melt when pressing)
