Who can resist shopping in these picturesque little shops in the second installment of our Village Wanderings series—Purveyors. Four delightful stores are filled with embroidered window boxes, fruits and vegetables, and even a wedding cake! Like the houses, each shop is framed with embroidered ribbon swags. We will learn how to construct each store in class, along with all the embroidery stitches needed to create your own set of shops! (Shops will be taught in wool but can be done in cotton.)

Ribbon, embroidery threads, and optional full kits will be available for sale. Design area of each is 8"x10".

Materials Needed:

- Needles—milliners #1, chenille #18, appliqué needles of choice
- Sharp scissors—paper and embroidery
- Appliqué thread
- Background fabric—10"x14" for each house
- SoftFuse Premium™ paperbacked fusible web
- Freezer paper
- Marking tool (chalk pencil or gel pen)
- Silk ribbon—4mm and 7mm (We used River Silks.)
- A variety of threads for embroidery: floss, wool, and pearl #3, 5, 8, and 12 (We used Weeks DyeWorks.)
- Pellon® SF101 Shape-Flex® woven, fusible interfacing
- Wool (or cotton) pieces in following sizes—
