For additional safety, Baltimore on the Prairie will add our own measures. I had the opportunity this past week to visit in-person with one of the leading infectious disease doctors in Kansas. He offered safety recommendations that are listed below. These are the basics right now as we are still working on specific details. Those will be explained in a July update.

1. We will follow health recommendations set forth by the Nebraska Dept. of Health, Otoe County and the City of Nebraska City, NE.
2. Wear face masks.
3. Observe social distancing.
4. Everyone will need to answer basic health questions.
5. Everyone will need to have their temperature taken.

Registrations are still being accepted for the 2020 conference but should it be cancelled, all monies received will be completely refunded or may be rolled over to the 2021 conference. Anyone who is currently registered may cancel their registration prior to August 1 and receive a full refund.
